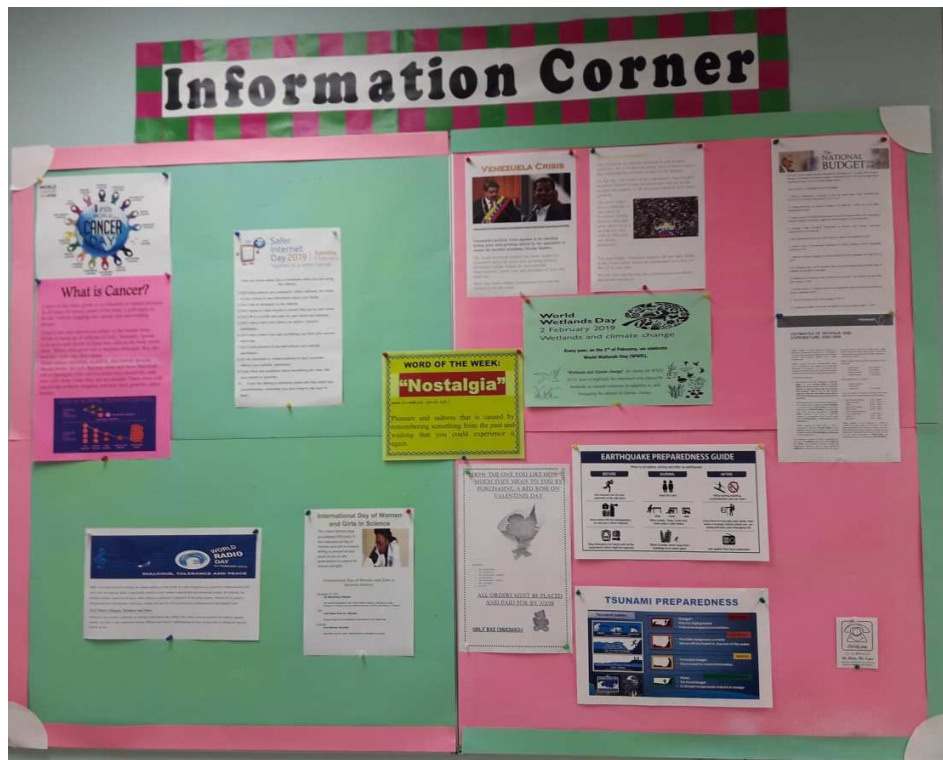

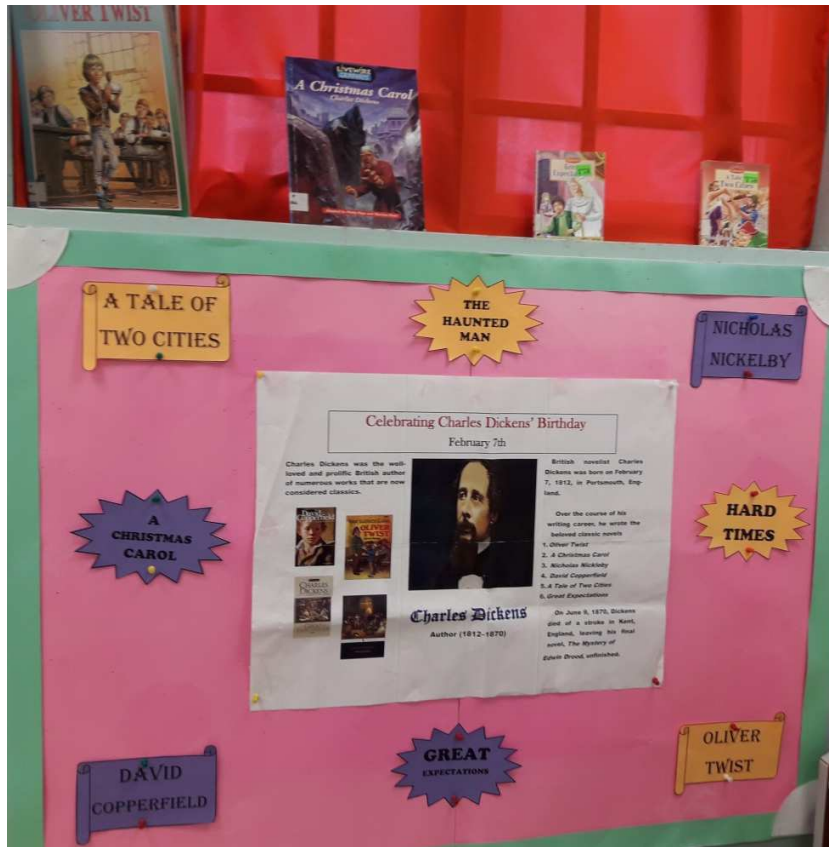

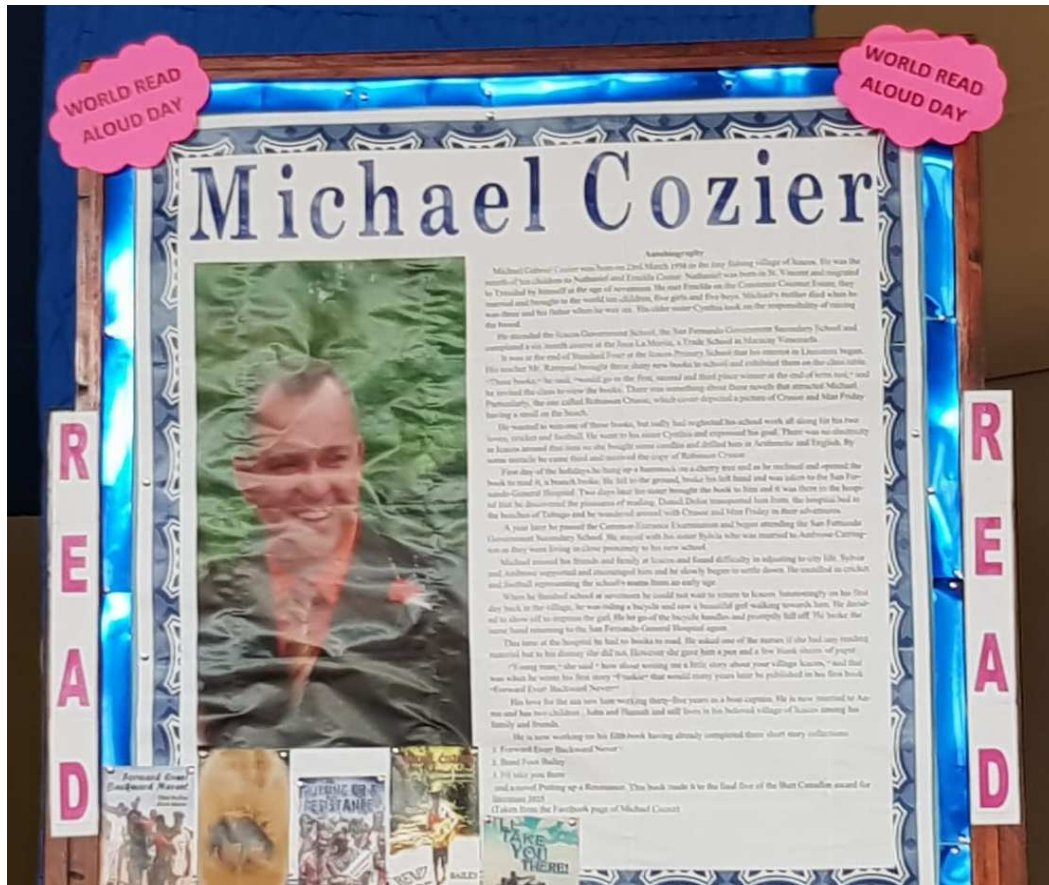
This term the School Library Media Centre celebrates World Read Aloud Day. World Read Aloud Day motivates children, teens, and adults by celebrating the power of words. This global literacy movement is about taking action to show the world that the right to read and write belongs to all people. World Read Aloud Day asks everyone to celebrate the day by grabbing a book, finding an audience, and reading out loud. In commemoration of World Read Aloud Day, we have conducted two activities. Firstly, students were invited to listen to the Last Lap by Paul Keens-Douglas followed by a visit by West Indian author, Michael Cozier. He is the author of Forward Ever! Backward Never!, Bend Foot Bailey, I'll Take You There and a novel Putting up a Resistance, which has been nominated for the Burt Canadian award for literature in 2015. Both activities are part of a NALIS initiative to foster the habit of reading while supporting local personalities. The SLMC also celebrated Valentine's Day with our annual Blind Date with a Book promotion. We have also proudly launched a new lending of multimedia resources service and our Ludo Club, which takes place every Wednesday during lunchtime.
